

## “Cinema at Sunset” Film Festival

BASWA (Business Association of the South Wedge Area) and George Eastman House present "Cinema at Sunset", a 5 day classic film festival to be held at the Highland Bowl starting Tuesday August 26 and running through Saturday August 30th. Films will be broadcast in 35mm reel to reel onto a 45' x 18' theatre screen.

Gates open at 5:30 PM, and each night we'll feature warm up music by local musicians such as the Hi Risers, Ancient Youth, Gordon Munding and Curtis Waterman, and the Darryl Parker Jazz Quartet. Music runs from 6:00 to 7:15, followed by shorts and animations from the Eastman Film collection. Each feature film will be introduced by curators from The Dryden Theatre. Features will start at dusk or by 8:00 PM. *Rain Location: The Dryden Theatre at the George Eastman House.*
